In addition to coordinating efforts with other state agencies, NJOHSP plays a critical role in helping to shape state and inter-state homeland security policy and practices. NJOHSP is led by Director Jared Maples and comprised of four Divisions: the Division of Intelligence, the Division of Policy and Planning, the Division of Cybersecurity, and the Division of Administration.

New Jersey Suspicious Activity Reporting System

- What is NJSARS?
 - **Terrorism and homeland security-related suspicious activity reports (SARs).**
- A SAR is “Official documentation of observed behavior reasonably indicative of preoperational planning related to terrorism or other criminal activity.”
- NJSARS disseminates SAR information throughout all levels of law enforcement.

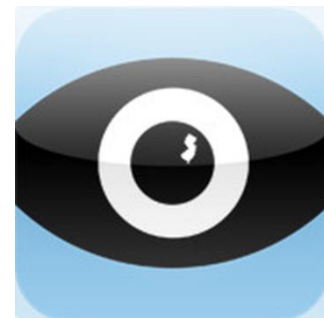
